



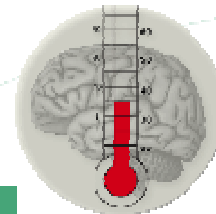
WebNeuro: Clinical Decision Support



WebNeuro assists healthcare professionals to determine:

A. Identification

- What is the risk for a mental problem?
- What distinguishing features does a patient have?



B. Management Plan

- Is medication indicated? What type might be more beneficial? Is psychotherapy indicated?
- Are there complexities (such as cognition problems), or multiple interactions and co-morbidities?



C. Review

- When to re-assess?



WebNeuro is available for:

Adults (WebNeuro Wellness) and Children aged 6 – 18 (WebNeuro Focus).

How it works:

Clinicians are provided with unique login IDs and passwords to allocate to their patients. Patients undertake a 30 minute web-based computerized assessment of their brain health. It can be undertaken by the patient at home or at the treating clinician's office. The patient's same login ID and password is used to objectively track the extent of improvement.

Immediately after completing WebNeuro, a report is emailed to the clinician. The report includes the patient's "signs and symptoms" scores plus objective measures of Cognition (for Emotion and Thinking) and Self Regulation (for risk and resilience).

Clinical Decision Support information is based on current published and consensus health knowledge for identifying depression, anxiety or ADHD disorders and for treatment plans and review.
